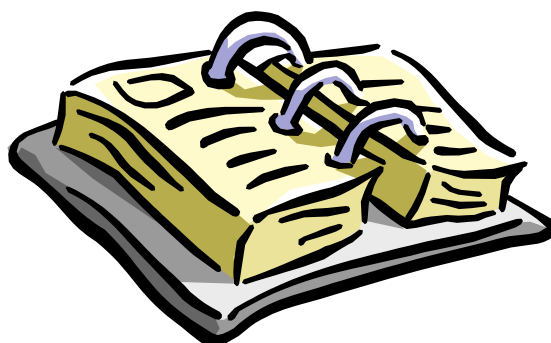
CARDIOLOGY - CVI RESEARCH SEMINAR
