The Patient Centered Medicine 2 Course includes lectures, small groups, workshops, clinical skills sessions, mastery sessions and OSCEs.

- Each PCM-2 educational session has a dedicated day/time on the course calendar.
- Attendance is mandatory for all PCM-2 sessions EXCEPT lectures that are designated as "ASYNCHRONOUS" or any other sessions designated as not mandatory. You are required to review any pre-recorded lecture material on your own time.
- Many lectures will be pre-recorded by faculty. The recordings will be posted on LUMEN
 & Sakai for students to view asynchronously.
- Questions on lecture content may be submitted via email to the speaker directly. If you email the speaker, please also copy in the PCM2 course directors.
- All small groups will be held on campus unless noted otherwise. If small group is held via Zoom, small group sessions are NOT to be recorded.
- Any session with guest patients may NOT be recorded.
- All workshops will be held on campus unless noted otherwise.
- All OSCEs will be held on campus unless noted otherwise.
- All integrated exams will be held on campus unless noted otherwise.
