

OB/GYN Clerkship Student Check List

Evaluations: All evaluations are completed by faculty/residents online. No paper evaluations will be accepted. Attendings/Residents are sent instructions on how to complete student online evaluations.

You may request evaluations from attendings/residents you work with through MyLumen by logging on mylumen. Click on “Clinical Performance Review”, request evaluation link. If you do not see the resident/attending on the drop down list, let me know and I will add them. Only Loyola OB/GYN attendings/residents are allowed to evaluate you; you are not to be evaluated by rotating or outside residents.

Patient Logs – (On MyLumen):

- ☐ Patient logs can be used to track daily tallies, but **you must log patients online at least weekly.** That will ensure us that you are having adequate exposure to patients. http://stritch.luc.edu/lumen/MedEd/obgyne/Patient_Log_2020_21.pdf
- ☐ Required Clinical Conditions must be updated weekly online.
- ☐ Update online patient log by the end of your clerkship.

Competency Yellow Card and Journal Club Evaluation: **Submit to Sakai**

- ☐ Ambulatory Clinic Card: All students are expected to participate in at least 4-half a day Ambulatory Clinics, this includes ONC, GYN, AMB, FPMRS. All must get four signatures and turn in the yellow ambulatory card.
- ☐ Student Article Presentation: All students must give a presentation to attending/resident during their time on the clerkship. Evaluation sheet must be completed and signed by attending/resident then turned in to Sakai.

Additional Sakai Assignments – PDF copies of assignments can be found on Sakai, assignments should be submitted to Sakai

- ☐ Core Clerkship Expectation – To be completed and turned in on first day of clerkship
- ☐ SMART Goals – to be completed by first Friday of clerkship
- ☐ Mid Clerkship Feedback Form – have completed by attending or resident
- ☐ PBL Evaluation – Bring in a copy of your PBL evaluation on your assigned day have filled out by facilitator. Take a picture and submit to Sakai. If there is more than one student presenting, only one evaluation needs to be completed, but both students must submit the picture.

- ☐ Journal Club Evaluation – Evaluation to be completed by attending/resident
- ☐ Scrub Competency Form - Print a copy and take with you at the start of your L&D rotation. Once you have it initialed and signed off by your preceptor, submit a copy to the Sakai assignment and give the form to Yara Anderson in the L&D Dept. Room 2028 (in the nurses station).

Prevention and Screen Exam: Located on Sakai, under the Tests & Quizzes tab. 20 question, untimed, true/false exam. Only one submission allowed, no retakes. Please complete by the end of week four (date also on Sakai calendar). Failure to submit by the due date will result in the score earned minus an additional 5 points. Failure to complete by 11:55pm on the last day of the clerkship will result in a 0.

Direct Observation Skills: Failure to complete by the end of the clerkship will result in being marked for Professionalism.
